MASS MEDIA

1. Introduction to Mass Communication and Evolution of Media

Explain the meaning and importance of Mass Communication. Study of different mediums (Radio, TV, Print, Internet)

Your project should include Definition and features of Mass Communication, Brief history of media in India, Evolution and growth of each medium, Comparison between traditional and modern media. (Pictures, logos, newspaper cuttings, interested facts related to media can be included)

2. Television Logic of Programming

Observe and analyse the programming pattern of any 4 television channels throughout one full day. Students have to study- *what type of content is shown at different times of the day *How channels target different audience groups *why specific programmes are shown at specific timings.

Analyse- *Morning programmes *Afternoon programmes *Prime-Time shows *Late-night content.

Include- *Names of the channels *Example of programmes/shows *Target audience of each programme *Genre of content.

3. Newspaper news analysis

Collect and analyse 10 news reports/headlines from newspapers. Paste the newspaper cuttings, Identify the category of news (Political news, Sports news, Crime news, international news, social news, etc). Analyse each report on the basis of- *Language used *Importance of the news.
