- Prevalence (age, gender, cultural factors)

- Background Information: Family, education, occupation, social relationships
- Presenting Problem: What symptoms or behaviors led to concern
- History of the Problem: Duration, triggering events, previous treatments
- Psychological Assessment: Tests used (if any), clinical observations

- Intervention/Treatment Plan: Therapy or medication used
- Prognosis: Expected outcome or current status
